"Each painting begins with inspiration followed by an intent for what I want to express with paint. Sometimes the intent is to simply capture the essence of the subject. In other paintings, I show the viewer a path to an inviting, yet mysterious place. I allow each painting to evolve, like a journey as I work on it. During the finishing process, I think again about what inspired me to choose the subject, as this is the heart of the painting and often the focus of light. I analyze the painting and through a variety of techniques and refine it to a level beyond the initial stage of capturing the subject. My goal is to create an expressive, impressionist work of art rather than an exacting portrait of the subject." When painting, I use all of my senses and my years of keen observation. I'm fascinated by nature's light, color, texture and patterns and I want to share my unique artistic vision with my viewers. This journey is the magic of my art."
